CONTACT DETAILS

Please could you make sure that you are fully contactable whilst your child is at Start Right in case we need to get in touch with you for accidents or if your child needs to be collected if they are showing symptoms. If you do change any personal contact details, please let us know as soon as possible.

WATERPROOFS AND WELLIES

Even though we are now in the Summer Term, the weather is still somewhat changeable!! Please could you ensure that children come in with clothes to equip them for both wet weather and sunshine.

At Forest School, we are having a great deal of fun, but often getting a little mucky, bringing in a set of spare clothes for each session would be much appreciated.

NAMING OF ITEMS

Please could you ensure that all you child's items are clearly named. This makes life at Start Right so much more straightforward!

FUNDED CHILDCARE

If your child qualifies for two year old or 30 hours funded childcare from the Council, please ensure that you update your status **every three months** to ensure that you continue to receive the funding.

If you are newly eligible for this funding, please speak to Jayne as soon as possible with your funding code and National Insurance number. There is a deadline to apply for this funding so please let us have any information as soon as you receive it. Any queries, please speak to Jayne.

REMINDERS

- We would appreciate a telephone call if your child is ill. If they have been sick, please make sure you do not bring them back to Start Right for at least 48 hours.
- If your child needs to take any medicine whilst at Start Right please speak to your child's key worker and they will ask you to complete a form.
- Please ensure that Start Right is informed of all people authorised to pick up your child and let a member of staff know if a relative or friend is collecting your child, especially if it is the first time.
- Please ensure that you include a cool pack in your child's lunch box and that you do not pack anything which contains nuts. Please also ensure that grapes and cherry tomatoes are cut in half. Please also send in a drink for your child in a non-spill cup.
